### **CV-19 Return to Rugby Emergency Fund**

It was announced in the WRU weekly update on Wednesday that a one off Return to Rugby Emergency Fund of £600,000 has been established. The criteria is currently being developed and further guidance will be issued on this shortly. This will be done in conjunction with a working group including representatives from a cross section of clubs across each area of Wales to ensure that we best support you in emerging from the Pandemic to return to rugby.
