Portable Floodlights

The Club Development Team has been in communication with Sport Wales regarding the possibility of clubs applying to the new Be Active Wales Progress Grant to purchase portable floodlights to assist in returning to rugby under the WRU protocols. With clubs incurring significant costs for hiring external venues, the purchase of portable floodlights could be a cost effective way of reducing monthly expenditure particularly for clubs with significant number of age groups. All applications are assessed by a Panel on individual merit and 3 quotations will need to be provided.
